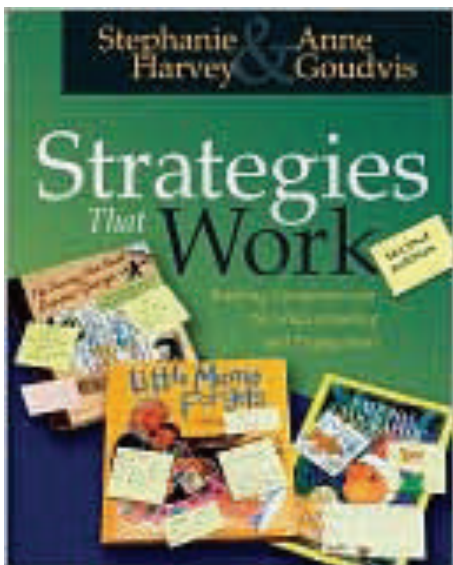


TARC and Anne Goudvis present:
